Subject: Reporting vaccination rates for congregate care residents

Dear Residential Service Providers.

Thank you for your ongoing collaboration and for the tremendous efforts you and your staff have made to help protect the people you support throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Ministry is requesting that service providers with congregate care settings collect the COVID-19 immunization status of **their residents (by site)** and share aggregate statistics with the ministry **by September 23, 2021**. Updates will be requested on a monthly basis thereafter.

Our objective is to undertake a sector-level review of resident vaccination rates to identify where additional supports and collaboration may be required. Service providers will not be penalized for low vaccination rates. We will provide service providers with a link to an online form. Attached is a guide to completing the service provider survey. In addition, a Q&A document that you can share with your residents and their families is attached.

Service providers **should not** disclose personal information or personal health information to the ministry (e.g. names, dates of birth, individual vaccination status). We are requesting only aggregate statistics, which may be shared with the Ministry of

Health or Public Health Units to support health-related measures including vaccine rollout. Service providers will need to ensure that the data is collected, retained and disposed of in a manner that respects privacy, including complying with the *Personal Health Information and Protection Act, 2004 (PHIPA)* and other relevant legislation where applicable.

If you are a placing agency, please share this package with any outside paid resources to have them complete the survey for residents under their care.

As you are aware, the province has announced that COVID-19 vaccination policies will be mandatory in higher-risk settings. More information on the reporting requirements report related to employees, staff, contractors, volunteers, and students will be coming in the near future.
